




- Data shows **the average number of days** on commercial cases in the Intermediate Court, from the Year 2015 to the Year 2019 (*Data is as of 18th January 2020*)
- The statistics shown below are divided into 3 stages; Filing & Service Stage (Stage 1), Trial & Judgment (Stage 2), Enforcement of Judgment (Stage 3)
- It is to be noted that not all files go through all process on each stage i.e. files may skip some steps, hence the number of days may varied on each case
- Targeted number of days for all stages (from Filling to execution) is 571 days
- Total average number of days for all stages in each year*:
 - 2015 – 1792 days
 - 2016 – 1451 days
 - 2017 – 1489 days
 - 2018 – 598 days
 - 2019 – 344 days

**Not all cases have completed all 3 stages (From filling to execution)*


AVERAGE NUMBER OF DAYS TAKEN FOR EACH COURT PROCESS




Total average number of days for Stage 2 (from Summons of Directions to Filing of Order)
