


- Data shows the average number of days on commercial cases in the Intermediate Court, from the Year 2015 to the Year 2019 (Data is as of 18th January 2020)
- The statistics shown below are divided into 3 stages; Filing & Service Stage (Stage 1),
 Trial & Judgment (Stage 2), Enforcement of Judgment (Stage 3)
- It is to be noted that not all files go through all process on each stage i.e. files may skip some steps, hence the number of days may varied on each case
- Targeted number of days for all stages (from Filling to execution) is 571 days
- Total average number of days for all stages in each year*:
 - o 2015 1792 days
 - o 2016 1451 days
 - o 2017 1489 days
 - o 2018 598 days
 - o 2019 344 days


^{*}Not all cases have completed all 3 stages (From filling to execution)

Total average number of days for Stage 1(from Filing of Writ to Close of Pleadings)


